Responsibilities

- Assigned projects including framing, insulating, finish carpentry, hanging sheetrock, painting, and related tasks.
- Contribute to project planning with the Facilities Manager; help create supply lists and project timelines.
- Regularly works weekend days. On call to respond to emergencies, alarms and urgent priorities related to buildings and grounds.
- Respond to electrical, plumbing, fire alarm and weather-related emergencies by contacting appropriate officials.
- Oversee snow removal and management.
- Maintain equipment. Diagnose malfunctions and repair equipment.
- Provide direction to maintenance workers and volunteers in performing repairs and working on building projects.
- Support Facilities Department functions (maintenance and housekeeping) as needed.
- Meet IMS's expectations for service excellence.
- Support and protect silent retreat environment; uphold ethical principles.

Qualifications/Experience

- 6+ years of maintenance, carpentry or construction experience including use of power and hand tools.
- A solid work ethic with strong organizational, time-management and problem-solving capabilities.
- Ability to work well independently and as part of a team; good interpersonal skills.
- A strong customer service background and orientation with a commitment to providing a high level of service.
- Flexible and comfortable with changing needs and priorities.
